

Citing Library Databases and E-books - APA Format 6th edition

For a journal or magazine article from a database there is a difference in when to include the issue number in the citation:

- For articles in journals whose page numbers run continuously through the volume do not include the issue number.
- For articles in journals whose page numbers start over with each issue of a volume include the issue number in parenthesis. The parenthesis and issue number are not italicized. Ex: 43(2)
