- *BIOL1400 cannot serve as a prerequisite for upper level BIOL courses

General Requirements

- This degree requires successful completion of 60 credit hours
- A minimum 2.00 cumulative grade-point average required for graduation
- In general, you must have a grade of "C" or better to transfer courses to a four-year institution.
- Satisfaction of all financial obligations is required for graduation
